A message from Chris & Jan Cooper

Welcome to this our 23rd holiday brochure. We have seen many changes over the years but never before have we seen a year like 2020. Tourism along with many other businesses has been severely hit by the pandemic and we have already seen the collapse of many coach operators and tour companies with probably more to come. We are so pleased to still be operating and cannot thank our customers enough for their support during these unprecedented times.

To assure our customers that your money is safe with us, as a legal requirement any money paid to us for a holiday is protected through an insurance which we pay for each and every passenger. This is International Passenger Protection financial failure insurance. However, any money paid to us for holidays is held in a separate account to our business account, namely a client account and only used at the time of a given holiday. If we have to cancel tours for any reason money can be refunded immediately or transferred to another holiday, whichever you choose, no credit notes and no waiting.

Measures to adhere to Government guidelines, and for your added safety while travelling during the Covid 19 pandemic include the fitting of electronic filters to the air supply units into the coach which eliminate biological pollutants such as bacteria, viruses, germs, allergens etc and reduce infection rates. Clear polythene blinds fitted between each double front facing seat as an additional physical barrier between passengers. The purchase of anti viral fogging machines used to sanitize the coach at the end of each day. Antibacterial gel hand sanitizers fitted to the entrance of the coaches. All hard surfaces are sanitized prior to the commencement of a journey and at intervals during the day whilst the coach is stationary.

You are no longer able to choose your seat as the coach will be loaded from the rear to the front in order of pick up and disembarking will be from the front to the rear allowing social distancing. The toilet will not be available unless it is extremely urgent and the driver is informed. However regular comfort stops will be made. Face coverings or masks should be worn unless there is a medical reason which prevents this. Should the 'R' number, the rate of infection fall, social distancing measures will gradually be relaxed and we will be able to return to a more normal way of organizing seating.

For your comfort and safety our coaches are non-smoking (which also includes electronic cigarettes) and seat belts which must be worn at all times.

Covid 19 clause. Although we are hoping that by 2021 we will be back to a more 'new normal' the holidays and inclusions described within this brochure are subject to change.

On a lighter note, within the brochure you will find a selection of 3 to 8 day tours. These are all good value for money but please remember when choosing a holiday that the price reflects the time of year, the facilities and standards offered by the hotels, venue entrances and guide fees.

The number of passengers we are able to carry is reduced, due to social distancing measures, so if there is something which takes your eye please make sure you book early to avoid disappointment.


